Selectboard Meeting

Approved 11/2/2015 minutes. Signed orders.

Old Business:

1. Windsor Police Chief William Sampson presented what his agency could provide the Town for policing services. He stressed how important community policing is to a community. He explained how the staff has turned over in the past year. He spoke of the new school resource officer hired with a four-year grant. He is very pleased with the professional level of his staff. Ten full-time and five part-time currently make up the Windsor Police Department. He strongly endorsed the concept of regional policing.
2. Discussed new intersection design to submit changes to David Saladino of VHB Engineers prior to his attendance at the December 7 meeting.

New Business:

1. Town-owned property adjacent to Hartland Elementary School: concern from residents about possible hunting on the property and the use of the property by school children. All were in agreement that hunting should not be permitted. Signs with the explanation of how the property is used may be designed and installed in addition to the "Safety Zone" signs that are already in place.
