Old Business:

1. Land Use Bylaws

Preston Bristow spoke about his suggestions for changes to the proposed Land Use Bylaws in response to comments made by those attending the last meeting. The next informational meeting is scheduled for December 2, 2013.

New Business:

1. Community Nurse: Paul Sawyer spoke as a representative of Aging in Hartland about the idea of having a part-time community nurse to provide support for Hartland residents with healthcare needs. The plan is for funding partially through grants and private donations. In addition Aging in Hartland will submit a petition for their request to appear on the Town warning at Town Meeting.

2. Net metering: Jay Boeri presented his proposal to sell energy to the town and school at an estimated annual savings of \$8400. The Board voted to accept the proposal pending our lawyer's approval of the contract.

3. 2015 Budget: John Sanders was here to explain the proposed budget for the fire department and give an update on the plan to replace vehicles.

4. Bob gave an overview of the Town Budget.

5. Campbell/Merritt fund requests: approved two fuel assistance requests.

6. Conservation Commission: Natalie Starr has resigned since she no longer lives in Hartland. Jared Ulmer was approved by the Board to join the Conservation Commission.

7. Dedication of new bank: Mascoma Bank held their ribbon-cutting ceremony for their new bank earlier in the day. Four Selectboard members attended and Bob was one of a few speakers congratulating Mascoma Bank on their new building.
