**ARTICLE 7:** Shall the Town vote the expenditure of \$6,000.00 from the Capital Reserve Fund to be used as the 20% portion of an Agency of Transportation Grant to complete a Three Corners Pedestrian Safety Scoping Study?

**ARTICLE 8:** Shall the Town vote to appropriate \$ \*\*\*\*\* of which \$ \*\*\*\*\* shall be raised by taxes, for Highways and General Fund expenses and all other purposes for which the law requires appropriations or the Town may legally vote?

**ARTICLE 9:** Shall the Town vote designate the Town of Hartland as a Property Assessed Clean Energy (PACE) District so that the Town may operate a program to enable participating property owners to access funding for eligible energy efficiency and renewable energy projects and then pay back the cost as a regular municipal assessment on that property owner's property tax bill?

**ARTICLE 10:** Shall the Town authorize the Selectboard to borrow money from the Capital Reserve Fund or a commercial lender for a term of no longer than five years for Town expenses in anticipation of taxes and to execute and deliver their note or notes or Selectboard's Orders thereof?

**ARTICLE 11:** To transact any other business necessary and proper under this warning including but not limited to the following:

A) Discussion of future police/public service for the Town

- Article 1:** To elect by Australian ballot, the Town School District officers for the ensuing year.
- Article 2:** To act on the reports of the School District officers for the past year.
- Article 3:** To see if the School District will vote to pay taxes to the Town Treasurer, such taxes to be collected on the same schedule voted at the Town Meeting.
- Article 4:** To see if the School District will vote to authorize the Board of School Directors to borrow money in anticipation of taxes to meet the requirements of the School District for the ensuing year and to authorize the execution and delivery of notes or orders to the School District.
- Article 5:** Shall the voters of the Hartland School District approve, by Australian ballot, a total budget in the amount of \$7,552,789 to provide grades K – 12 education for the year beginning July 1, 2012?
- Article 6:** Shall the voters of the Hartland School district approve, by Australian ballot, the transfer of \$379,000 from the Hartland School District General Fund to the Hartland School District Capital Reserve Fund for future upkeep and renovations of the school facilities and grounds?
- Article 7:** To transact any other business which may properly come before the meeting.
