Topics Discussed:

- Notes from our February, 2015 meeting were approved as written.
- Jennifer then spoke briefly of the presentation to Ginny White at Town Meeting of this year's conservation award. Ginny has sent a note of appreciation to us.
- She then announced that Jared will be leaving the commission. We now have two vacancies and members should come to the April meeting with suggestions to fill these positions.
- Rob spoke of attending the gathering of the Upper Valley Conservation Committee.
- Knox suggested it was hard to know the direction of the Town's policy on ancient roads. Jennifer said Bob Stacey has a map showing class 1, 2, 3 and 4 roads in town. This map should be available to all.
- Continuing our discussion of having surveys done on Town owned properties Bill Stack has done some of the survey points on the 17 acre wood but others remain to be found. We may be able to utilize survey information from adjoining properties.
- Some time was spent on the upcoming 4-April presentation we are giving at the community breakfast. Sumner's Falls will be the focus but other town owned properties will be mentioned. Public feedback should be sought on plans to utilize these parcels. Details of the breakfast should be sent to the Town list serve, Judy Howland for inclusion in her VT Standard column and a poster prepared for outside Damon Hall.
- Cordie reported on the meeting of the CT River Joint Commission. They are proposing 3 boat launch facilities on the NH side of the river. She said only Hartford has a swift water rescue squad. Signage may need to be replaced and a more current warning system of high water implemented.
