**Topics Discussed:**

- Our Notes from September were approved as written.
- Jennifer welcomed Kay to our meeting and gave her a brief introduction to our history and activities. Kay, in turn, invited our members to one of their meetings on the first Wednesday of the month, 5:30 in the Windsor Welcome Center.
- Dean presented our latest water testing data. Permission was given to publicize it on the Town web site and listserv. This would provide the public with information needed to make wise decisions regarding exposure to our waters. Posting will begin with next year's results.
- Charles Jeffries has updated our information on the Town website. He has put up our 2013 and 2014 annual reports, corrected our member list, contact information and posted our agenda for this meeting.
- Rob reported on the recent selectboard (SB) meeting regarding the 17 acre wood. They sounded very supportive of Jeff Moreno's ideas for the parcel. They did ask for more detailed information on exactly how he hopes to utilize the property for educational purposes. They did agree to fund a formal survey of points 9, 10, 11, and 12 on Bill Stack's map. The SB did express safety concerns if "volunteers" were to begin clearing and removing dead fall. The survey aside, the next step seems to be up to Jeff to provide the information requested. The SB did say that Jeff could begin soliciting funding for the ideas he has including the use of Martinsville Road to establish an ADA acceptable access site.
- Chris has drafted a letter asking to join our commission. Jennifer will present this to the SB.
- Conservation easements on Town owned properties was discussed again.
- The GreenUp Day committee responded that individuals and towns will not be subject to legal action if volunteers do not segregate materials collected by volunteers into trash and recyclables. Dean sent this information on to Ginny White.
- Rob is trying to put our water testing data into graph/table form. Dean will contact the Corps of Engineers to see if they have E.coli numbers from North Hartland Lake.
- Our local Boy Scout troop has several members seeking Eagle Scout projects.
