Topics Discussed:

- Minutes from October were approved as written.
- Chris's application for membership will be given to the town in the near future.
- Next year's budget request is due 1-December. Our annual report (AR) is also due on the same date. Jennifer will prepare one.
- Chris will put our previous AR's on PDF files.
- We received E. coli data from North Hartland Lake for this season's May-September tests. Of their weekly tests only one had a value over the state allowed limit for safe usage.
- Dean reported that the Hartland Nature Club's herbarium will soon be on its way to the Pringle Herbarium at UVM.
- Jennifer has sent several suggestions for Eagle Scout projects to the local troop.
- Hunting on the 17 acre wood is on the selectboard agenda for 16-November. Rob and Dean will try to attend. The suggestion was made to utilize the town road crew to clean up dead fall to make the area safer for school use.
- Bob has communicated that he could show us the western corners of the Sumner's Falls property. He is away until the 16th. Dean will contact him to arrange a time and place and let all know so some could join in if available.
- Jennifer will check to see if there is an easement on the property at the exit 9 park and ride lot.
- Guy gave out a printout of the latest temperature data from Lull's Brook. He also brought up an erosion problem on the Meecham Farm in North Hartland. The state has claimed no responsibility.
- There was a wide ranging discussion on the Community Sponsored Array (CSA) Knox is hosting on this farm. It will occupy about 1 acre and construction is progressing quickly. It may be the first CSA completely subscribed before it comes on line.
