**ARTICLE 1:** To elect, by Australian ballot, Town officers and Town School District officers for the ensuing year. The ballot box will be open at 7:00 a.m. and close at 7:00 p.m.

**ARTICLE 8:** Shall the Town vote to include the reading of the Declaration of Independence as part of the festivities that take place on July 4<sup>th</sup>?

**VOTING BY AUSTRALIAN BALLOT: March 3, 2015**  
**Polls open 7:00 AM — 7:00 PM**

- Article 1:** To elect by Australian ballot, the Town School District officers for the ensuing year.
- Article 2:** To act on the reports of the School District officers for the past year.
- Article 3:** To see if the School District will vote to pay taxes to the Town Treasurer, such taxes to be collected on the same schedule voted at the Town Meeting.
- Article 4:** To see if the School District will vote to authorize the Board of School Directors to borrow money in anticipation of taxes to meet the requirements of the School District for the ensuing year and to authorize the execution and delivery of notes or orders to the School District.
- Article 5:** Shall the voters of the Hartland School District approve, by Australian ballot, a total budget in the amount of \$8,660,858 to provide grades K — 12 education for the year beginning July 1, 2015?
- Article 6:** Shall the voters of the Town of Hartland authorize the Hartland Board of School Directors to withdraw \$175,000 from the Capital Reserve Fund to do the following respective improvements: **Asbestos abatement** (\$28,000); **Final phase of locker replacement** (\$20,000); **Replacement of tractor for snow removal from sidewalks/walkways/fire exits and other general purposes** (\$20,000); **Door/hardware replacement to improve security and comply with ADA regulations** (\$72,000); and **Replacement of the fire panel** (\$35,000).
- Article 7:** Shall the voters of the Town of Hartland authorize the Hartland Board of School Directors to move the Annual School Meeting to the Monday evening one week prior to Town Meeting beginning on February 29, 2016 and every year subsequent to that year until the voters approve otherwise.
- Article 8:** To transact any other business which may properly come before the meeting.
