Old Business:

1. Policing survey: discussion concerning the responses on the survey. Most people seem satisfied with the current level of policing with perhaps additional hours provided by the Vermont State Police. Most people indicated feeling safe in town all or most of the time.
2. Fire pit on Foster Meadows property: The Select Board will plan a site visit at our next meeting to look at the possible spots for a fire pit as requested by the Scouts.
3. Bob has not heard back from Nancy Eastman. Her fence was supposed to have been completed by June 1, 2016.
4. Lovers Lane: The Board agreed that a speed survey installed on Lovers Lane would help determine the need to lower the speed limit. Bob will find out more about whether a speed survey is a possibility.

New Business:

1. Library Trustees: Amy Wisehart spoke about the icy and muddy conditions in the Library parking lot. She and the Library Board are convinced that paving the parking lot would make the Library more accessible during all weather conditions. Bob had gotten a quote of \$39,000 to pave the driveway and parking. Joe Olmstead suggested regrading and hardpack as a better alternative. Bob said that work could be completed this summer.
